RE: Return of \$40,000 fee

Dear Mr. Bisceglie:

As you know, since on or about July 22, 2011 this local union is the direct successor in interest to former Local 1456 of the New York City & Vicinity District Council of Carpenters, United Brotherhood of Carpenters.

On or about June 25, 2011, Local 1456 entered into an agreement with you to provide legal services and paid to you a fee of \$40,000. For that fee you apparently wrote two letters (July 14, 2011 and July 21, 2011) totaling five and a half pages.

Local 1556 has learned that, when entering into the June 25, 2011 agreement to provide legal services to Local 1456, you were involved in a concurrent conflict of interest by establishing and installing yourself as the president of a competing labor organization named Amalgamated Carpenters and Joiners Union. According to the Form LM-1 that you filed with the United States Department of Labor, you established the Amalgamated Carpenters on June 8, 2011, over two weeks before beginning representation of Local 1456.



In addition, you have a current conflict of interest given that the Amalgamated Carpenters is attempting to represent certain employee-members of the former Local 1456 who are now members of Local 1556. This is a violation of your duty to the former client in a substantially related matter where the interests of Local 1456 (now Local 1556) and the Amalgamated Carpenters are materially adverse.

For the above reasons, you are directed to return to Local 1556 as the direct successor to Local 1456 the \$40,000 previously paid to you. I expect to receive your firm's check in the amount of \$40,000 payable to Local 1556 by the close of business on Monday, March 12, 2011. If you fail to refund the \$40,000, Local 1556 will pursue any and all remedies available to it to recover the \$40,000 fee and otherwise to hold you liable for your past and current conflicts of interest.
